In reading this week, we are going to study "The Hallo-Weiner". We will cover story elements (character, setting, problem, resolution, and sequencing). We are still working on rhyming words (nursery rhymes and word families help tremendously with this) and alliteration (Sally sells seashells by the seashore.) Our vocabulary words for the week will be: unusual, farewell, dashed, gathered. In Saxon Phonics, we will continue to review the letters and sounds we have gone over so far...p, t, n, s, m, d, g, a, e, o, i, c, k, and ck. We will continue to review the short "a" and "e" word families. I know this may sound redundant but if they don't know their sounds, they will always struggle. It is my goal that they will leave me knowing all of their letters and sounds. In Handwriting Without Tears, we will work on correct letter formations with different letters and numbers. In math, we will be working on simple addition, decomposing numbers, patterns, classroom graphs, and counting to 120 orally. In social studies, we will discuss making good choices. In science, we will continue discussing matter and will have some fun experiments this week. We are also studying a timeline over our months, seasons, and holidays. We go over the calendar daily.
