All policies and procedures for use of ESSER III Funds will address how the Greenville School District will RESPOND to, PREPARE for and PREVENT the spread of COVID-19 in the reopening of in-person education.

The following are a list of suggestions to consider:

- The extent to which and how the funds will be used to implement prevention and mitigation strategies that are, to the greatest extent practicable, consistent with the most recent CDC guidance on reopening schools, to continuously and safely open and operate schools for in-person learning.
- How the LEA will use the funds it reserved to address the academic impact of lost instructional time through the implementation of evidence-based interventions, such as summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day, comprehensive afterschool programs, or extended school year.
- How the LEA will spend its remaining ARP ESSER funds consistent with the uses authorized in the ARP Act; and
- How the LEA will ensure that the interventions it implements, including but not limited to those implemented will respond to the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of students, and particularly those students disproportionately impacted by COVID-19, including students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care and migratory students.
