SUBJECT: Asbestos-Containing Building Materials

In compliance with the Environmental Protection Agency=s Asbestos-Containing Materials in Schools Rule of October 30, 1987, and the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality=s LAC 33:111.27, we wish to notify you of the following:

- 1. Asbestos is a building material that has been used in floor tile, ceiling tile, insulation, and several other materials for many years. Asbestos fibers can cause serious health effects if they are not sealed into a material.
- 2. Altec Environmental Consulting, LLC conducted an inspection of the building for asbestos-containing building materials. You may view a copy of the asbestos inspection report and action plan by contacting the principal. The action plan, also known as an asbestos management plan, includes a description of asbestos containing materials in the building, procedures for re-inspecting the building every six months, and a schedule for removing any existing asbestos materials.
- 3. We want you to know that we have instituted procedures which will assist us in maintaining asbestos in the building in a safe condition until it is removed. We will continue to keep you informed of new actions regarding asbestos.
