

We are so excited to start school and see the kids again! Here are some important procedures to begin the new school year. We may modify as needed.

1. This year, students cannot congregate in the cafeteria before school. The students will go straight to their first period class. Classroom doors open at 7:45am. Breakfast will be eaten in the 1st period classroom. Breakfast is free for each student.
2. Our Visitor Protocols have also changed. No visitors are allowed on campus. If you need to pick up your student, please come to the main office in the courtyard. You will need to remain in the office and your child will come to you.

Parents: you cannot walk your students to class.

There will be many staff members to help the students get to their classes the first few days. Because you cannot walk your child to class, you are encouraged to attend Meet the Indians / Meet the Teacher on Friday, August 14th. It is a come-and-go event from 12noon-7pm. While there, you and your child can drop off school supplies, see the room, and meet the teachers.

3. Students, please bring your mask / face shield (4th-12th) and your pre-filled water bottle each day. We will have each available if needed.

4. Students will walk on the right side of the hallway and "keep moving."

Screening Questions for you to ask your student each morning:

1. Has the student come into close contact with anyone who has been lab confirmed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
2. Have they recently begun experiencing any of the following in a way that is not normal for your them:

Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
Loss of smell or taste
Difficulty breathing
Shortness of breath
Cough
Sore throat
Headache
Chills
Shaking or exaggerated Shivering
Significant muscle pain or ache
Diarrhea
