#### **Comfort Athletic Booster Club Mission Statement**

The Comfort Athletic Boosters Club is a charitable, non-profit organization made up of an action-oriented group of parents, community members, volunteers, and administrators. Through dedication and teamwork, we support the enhancement of the athletic experience of Comfort High School athletes, their teams, and their fans through the promotion of athletics, school spirit, successful student-athletes, and community awareness of their athletic & academic achievements. The Booster Club recognizes that participation in High School athletics benefits everyone, and the Booster Club endorses the opportunity to build and strengthen relationships among all involved; the student body, CHS staff and administration, parents, and community.

# Eligibility, Selection of Recipients, and Disbursement of Funds

The Comfort Athletic Booster Club awards four (4) scholarships for post-secondary education vocational or academic studies. To be considered for a scholarship, student members must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Booster Club Membership. The student or family member must be a member of the Comfort Athletic Booster Club by December 31, 2021. **Applicants must be athletes/cheerleaders/managers/trainers.**
- 2. Academic Scholarship. Applying student must have a minimum cumulative **unweighted** high school grade point average **(GPA)** of **3.0** on a **4.0** scale.
- 3. Vocational Scholarship. There is no GPA requirement for the Vocational Scholarship. If there are no vocational scholarship applicants, the CABC may award an additional academic scholarship.
- 4. Post-Secondary Education. The applicant must be accepted by a post-secondary institution to receive scholarship. Post-secondary institutions include, but are not limited to, colleges, universities, and technical and vocational schools.
- 5. Application Form and Submission. Students must complete and submit the application with <u>all</u> required forms and information in a sealed envelope with "CABC Scholarship Application" written on the front to the Comfort High School Counselor by April 4, 2022.
- 6. Selection Committee. Parents and family members of the applicant(s) may not serve on the selection committee. The selection committee will holistically review each application. Each student's academic record, extracurricular activities, community service, work experience, letters of recommendation, and essay will be part of the review & selection process.
- 7. Scholarship Recipients. Winners will be announced at the End of year Awards Banquet or Spring Athletic Award's Ceremony.
- Disbursement of Funds. Recipients must provide a copy of their fee receipt (statement), class schedule indicating full time status, and address of the Institution's Financial Aid or Business Office in which to send funds. At that time, CABC will pay the scholarship amount in the recipient's name directly to the Financial Aid or Business Office of the accredited institution.
