Semester Test Exemptions Comfort High School

A student may be exempt from taking their semester test for any class, unless the test is required by a college through a dual credit or *OnRamps* course, provided each of the following requirements have been met.

- 1. Student's grades and attendance must meet the one following guidelines.
 - Class grade average is greater than or equal to 90 AND up to 3 absences; OR
 - Class grade average is greater than or equal to 85 AND up to 1 absence; OR
 - Class grade average is greater than or equal to 80 AND no absences.
 - * Students with a grade average less than 80 will not receive test exemptions.

* These absences do not include medically excused absences under the state guidelines, excused absences allowed under the college visitation policy, absences due to religious holy days, required court appearances, activities related to a student obtaining U.S. Citizenship, service as an election clerk, or absences for schoolsponsored activities. Written documentation by a physician will be considered when determining exemptions for illnesses.

- 2. Student may have no placements or days in In-School Suspension (ISS).
- 3. Student may have no out of school suspensions or DAEP placements.
