Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees fahrenheit2. Loss of taste or smell3. Cough4. Difficulty breathing5. Shortness of breath6. Fatigue7. Headache8. Chills9. Sore Throat10. Congestion or runny nose11. Shaking or exaggerated shivering12. Diarrhea13. Nausea or vomiting	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Immediately Report to the School Nurse for guidance2. Seek medical Attention3. Principal notifies maintenance to clean the exposed area.4. Individual who has symptoms and not evaluated by medical professional or tested for Covid I cannot return to School until the school nurse screens the individual to determine conditions for re-entry have been met.
