AXA Achievement Scholarship - Up to \$25,000 – Applicant must demonstrate: ambition and drive, determination to set and reach goals, respect for self, family and community, ability to succeed in college. The deadline has not yet been confirmed but they did say they're hoping to keep the same time frame as last year which was in the spring. Check the website frequently for their updates!

"B. Davis Scholarship" \$1,000. This scholarship Deadline: May 21, 2023. You will write an essay describing 3 characteristics of leadership that you value most and discuss why you believe these traits are important and how you feel they are developed in an individual. The **Mohler Scholarship** application window is now open until January 20, 2023. Criteria: Student will write an essay and must complete the application found in the Guidance Office, have a letter of recommendation from a non-family, community member and a survey of reference from 2 faculty members or a non-family community member. Applicants must have SAT/ACT scores and FAFSA on file, must be a current graduating senior of BHS with a minimum 2.7 GPA, and must have plans to attend college on a full-time basis. There are many steps to this application so do not wait until the final day!

LFCU Ted Hitch Scholarship Program: \$5000. Applicant or parent/guardian must be a member of Liberty Federal Credit Union for at least 18 months prior to application deadline which is February 24, 2023. Knights of Pythias: Grand Domain of Indiana Educational Assistance Program: \$1000. 3.0 GPA, transcript and 2 essays: 600 words or less about your goals after graduating from college and 600 words or less regarding your need of financial help. Due before January 25, 2023. Applications are in the Guidance Office, but they must be mailed to the address on the application. The GO does not collect them.

IUPUI is providing a scholarship opportunity for high-achieving, underrepresented minority juniors and seniors. The **George W Carver Teaching Initiative (CTI)** is a scholarship and career development program dedicated to the recruitment, retention, and support in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) teaching careers. CTI scholars receive up to \$33,000 in scholarship support; paid summer internships, professional networking and career building opportunities, and support with job placement.
