<u>BIG SUN Scholarship:</u> Deadline: November 30, 2022. \$500. Must be a high school senior and currently involved in a school or community sport as a player, coach or official. Please visit the website: http://www.bigsunathletics.com to learn how to apply.

"B. Davis Scholarship" \$1,000. This scholarship Deadline: May 21, 2023. <u>CYBA: Chandler Youth Basketball Association:</u> You will need completed application, 2 page essay, letter of acceptance to college, and transcript. Must have a 2.5 GPA or above, played a season with CYBA, and plan to attend college after high school. More details on the application, which can be picked up from the GO. Due: April 9, 2023

<u>DAR: Daughters of the American Revolution</u> – Celebrate Stars and Stripes Forever, 9 – 12 grade, Select a figure from the era of the American Revolution (1773-1783). Discuss how he or she influenced the course of the American Revolution, who he or she was, and his/her contribution to the founding of a new nation. Your figure may be any person, whether a well-known figure or an everyday man, woman or child who supported the American Revolution in ways large or small. Essay is to be between 800 and 1200 words. Essays must be typed and turned into the Guidance office no later than <u>November 15</u>. More info in the GO and on Google Classroom. <u>Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student Scholarship</u>: Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. <u>Indiana State University</u> – Scott College of Business is offering the Gongaware Scholarship for those interested in a career in risk management, insurance or financial services. \$9,000 per year. It will provide 200 students up to \$7,500 per year in exchange for agreeing to teach in IN for 5 consecutive years. Students applying must be current high school senior on track to graduate, be in top 20% of class OR have a top 20% ACT/SAT score, submit a completed application at ScholarTrack.IN.gov, and Submit a 2021-2022 FAFSA. IUPUI is providing a scholarship opportunity for high-achieving, underrepresented minority juniors and seniors. The **George W Carver Teaching Initiative** (CTI) is a scholarship and career development program dedicated to the recruitment, retention, and support in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) teaching careers. CTI scholars receive up to \$33,000 in scholarship support; paid summer internships, professional networking and career building opportunities, and support with job placement. IUPUI will: recruit high school students, provide college freshmen and sophomores with internships, and provide college junior and seniors with scholarships. <u>Johnson Foundation</u>: Interested in going to college to major or minor in Journalism, Communications, Media or Music? The recipient of this award must meet the following criteria: 2.7GPA or above, have plans to attend college full time, require financial assistance, have an SAT/ACT score on file, and cannot be a relative of anyone on the Foundation Board or High School committee. Inquire with the Guidance office if interested. Applications are due Tues, January 31, 2023.

The Mohler Scholarship application window will be November 21st, 2022 until January 20, 2023. Make sure to attend the informational meeting on November 21st in the auditorium during Part B of the PT. Criteria: Student will write an essay and must complete the application found in the Guidance Office, have a letter of recommendation from a non-family, community member and a survey of reference from 2 faculty members or a non-family community member. Applicants must have SAT/ACT scores and FAFSA on file, must be a current graduating senior of BHS with a minimum 2.7 GPA, and must have plans to attend college on a full-time basis

<u>Play For Kate, Inc Scholarship:</u> have a minimum of 3.0 GPA. \$\$500-\$1000 (depending on bank interest accrued). Application and required information must be received by Friday March 31st, 2023. You can choose to mail them at the given address or give to the Guidance office by March 28, 2023 and she will mail them for you. You will need to include a typed essay on one of the topics (on application), 3 letters of recommendation, a letter of acceptance to college and your high school transcript.

<u>Yankeetown Alumni</u>: To qualify for this \$150, you must be a Yankeetown graduate with a 2.0 GPA or higher and write a short essay explaining your continuing education plans. (Note: Do no put your name on the essay, it will be numbered to match your application). Applications are available in the BHS Guidance Office and due back to Mrs. Lashley by April 1, 2023.

<u>INCPAS Scholars Program</u>: This scholarship is for under-represented US racial/ethnic minority students from IN who have an interest in accounting and/or business.

<u>Hagan Scholarship</u>: These merit-based scholarships are open to graduating seniors who will be attending a not-for-profit 4-year college/university in the US. Deadline December 31, 2022.

<u>The Frank O'Bannon Grant</u>: This grant is for IN residents with financial need, who will attend eligible public, private and proprietary postsecondary institutions.

<u>IN State University Rural Health Scholarship</u> full in-state tuition: for students who have a strong interest in providing care to family and friends in rural IN, specifically as a primary care physician. (renewable for up to 3 additional years; but not designed for students interested in becoming nurses, physician assistants, or any allied health occupation).

<u>Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest</u>: to recognize up-and-coming artists and encourages patriotism in youth. Students in grades 9-12. Digital art, photograph and jewelry are not accepted. Teacher or counselor signature required on application. 1st place: \$15,000. 2nd: \$7,500. 3rd: \$3500. 4th and 5th: \$1,500. 6th – 10th: \$500. 2 and 3 dimensional submissions. Presidential Scholarship

Application Deadline: November 15, 2022

Competitive award for Indiana residents who have a 4.0 cumulative GPA and SAT score of 1280 or ACT of 27. The scholarship provides full tuition and housing costs along with a yearly stipend for books and meals.

Baccalaureate/Doctor of Medicine Scholarship

Application Deadline: November 15, 2022

Competitive award for Indiana residents who have a 3.5 cumulative GPA and SAT score of 1280 or ACT of 27 who plan to pursue medical school. The scholarship provides full tuition for four years of undergraduate study and provisional acceptance into the Indiana University School of Medicine.

Multicultural Leadership Scholarship Application Deadline: December 10, 2022

Amount: \$5,000 per academic year for four years

Description: Awarded to students who demonstrate academic achievement and leadership in diverse organizations, environments and leadership capacity for civic engagement and within the workplace.

USI Foundation Scholarships

Application Deadline: January 31, 2023

Amount: \$500-\$2,000

Description: Funded through the generosity of private donors. There are approximately 100 USI Foundation scholarships reserved for new, incoming freshmen. A student's application matches you with any scholarships for which they meet the criteria set forth by the donor. Students can submit thier USI Foundation Scholarship application through their myUSI account.
