Purpose: Franklin County Schools League of Honor exists to recognize

former Franklin County Schools' students and employees whose lives exemplify positive accomplishments and contributions to

society.

Number of Honorees: A maximum of one former student and one former employee may

be recognized annually.

Nomination Process: Open nominations. The formal nomination form must be

completed and returned to the Superintendent of Schools no later than May 15th. A one to two page letter, including resume information which communicates the nominee's achievements as stated in the Purpose, should accompany the form. Relevant information may include education, career, community/civic service and family data. Nominations received will be considered only for that year. A nominee not selected must be re-submitted in

the same manner for further consideration.

Timeline: January – May 15 Nominations period

May 15 Deadline for nominations
June 15 Committee selection date

Honoree Plaques: A 10"x12" cast aluminum or bronze plaque would be attached to

an existing brick column in the courtyard. Each plaque would contain the person's name, profession or career, years (date) as a student or employee, and personal information. Each plaque can

hold six lines with a total maximum of 120 characters.

Funding: The MVISD School Board is asked to budget \$1,200 each school

year to cover costs.

Selection Committee: The Superintendent will appoint new committee members to serve

a three-year term. Committee members will serve a January through December calendar term. There will be eight committee members who will consist of four community members and four District committee members. The Superintendent of Schools will

serve as an Ex-Officio member.
