PLANNING FOR MULTIPLE SPACES

Construction for this bond will impact more than just one area of the elementary campus. In the picture below, the yellow indicates areas reserved for new construction. The blue areas show where all renovations will occur.

The orange shows a safer area to relocate the playground away from the road.

A new office and an secure entrance, library, and at least twelve new classrooms are being planned.

Construction would take place in multiple phases and would be accelerated during the summer months.

THE IMPACT AT HOME

This bond asks individual taxpayers for an additional I&S tax of .07 cents.

Excluding 2021, this new tax rate would be lower than any rate passed in the past 10 years.

For a home with a market value of \$150,000, this would be tax increase of less than \$6.50 per month.

This would equate to a annual increase of \$77.00.
