

## 13 Colonies Map Instructions

Follow the instructions in order to ensure that you get all the information necessary to your knowledge of the 13 colonies.

1. On the back of your map, put your name, date, class period.
2. Fold your paper horizontally (hamburger fold) across to cover the map up.
3. Cut 3 flaps into the page covering the map.
  - a. label the top flap New England colonies and color it red.
  - b. label the middle flap Middle colonies and color it yellow.
  - c. label the bottom flap Southern colonies and color it green.
4. Open the flaps and title the map 13 Colonies across the top of the page, above the map.
5. Label each colony using the map provided in your notes (p.37).
6. Label the Atlantic Ocean and color it blue.
7. Label the Appalachian Mountains and draw them in on the map (western border of the middle colonies).
8. Color the colonies according to what region they are in:
  - a. New England - red
  - b. Middle - yellow
  - c. Southern – green
9. Create a map key in the bottom right hand corner of your map, explaining the colors.
10. On the inside of the flap for each region, you must identify the following:
  - a) Physical geography (what the land/climate is like)
  - b) Economic activities (what the people do for money)
  - c) Human features (what groups of people are in the colony)
