

Missouri Compromise Map Instructions

1. Write the map title at the **top** of the map: **Missouri Compromise Map**
2. Create a map key in the **bottom, left** corner of the map. Draw 3 squares. Label 1 free states, label the 1 slave states, label 1 Missouri Compromise states.
3. Label the following states on the map:
 - a. Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, New York, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, New Jersey
 - b. Color these states **blue**
 - c. In your map key, color the square labeled free states blue.
4. Label the following states on the map:
 - a. Missouri, Kentucky, Maryland, Virginia (West Virginia is still part of Virginia at this time), North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Florida
 - b. Color these states **red**
 - c. In your map key, color the square labeled slave states red.
5. Draw black stripes through the states of Missouri and Maine.
 - a. In your map key, draw stripes through the 3rd square labeled Missouri Compromise states
6. Draw a thick black line across Missouri's southern border to Texas' panhandle border. **DO NOT CROSS TEXAS.**
 - a. Label this black line the 36, 30 Missouri Compromise Line.

Compromise of 1850 Map Instructions

1. Write the map title at the **top** of the map: **Compromise of 1850**
2. Create a map key in the **bottom, left** corner of the map. Draw 3 squares. Label 1 free states, label the 1 slave states, label 1 popular sovereignty states.
3. Label the following states on the map:
 - a. Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, New York, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Iowa, California, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas, New Jersey
 - b. Color these states **blue**
 - c. In your map key, color the square labeled free states blue.
4. Label the following states on the map:
 - a. Missouri, Kentucky, Maryland, Virginia (West Virginia is still part of Virginia at this time), North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Florida, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas
 - b. Color these states **red**
 - c. In your map key, color the square labeled slave states red.
5. Label the following states on your map:
 - a. Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, New Mexico
 - b. Color these states **yellow**
 - c. In your map key, color the square labeled popular sovereignty
