Notice Regarding Directory Information for All Other Purposes

This objection must be made in writing to the principal within **10 school days** of your child's first day of instruction for this school year as outlined in the Student Handbook under the heading "**Consent, Opt-Out, and Refusal Rights: Objecting to the Release of Directory Information**".
