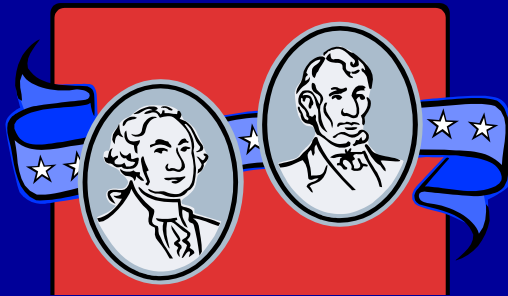




Biography:

person

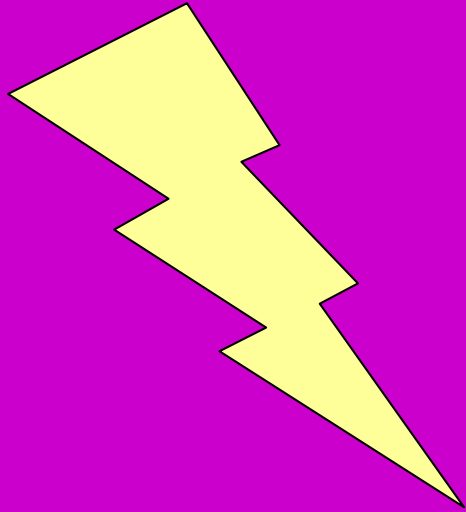




Non-fiction:

Fantasy:

Folktale:

A story often with a message,

by word of mouth





Historical Fiction:

A fictional story with real and invented characters that takes place during a historical time



Mystery:

A suspenseful story about a puzzling event that is not solved until the end of the story.

A verse written to
inspire thought

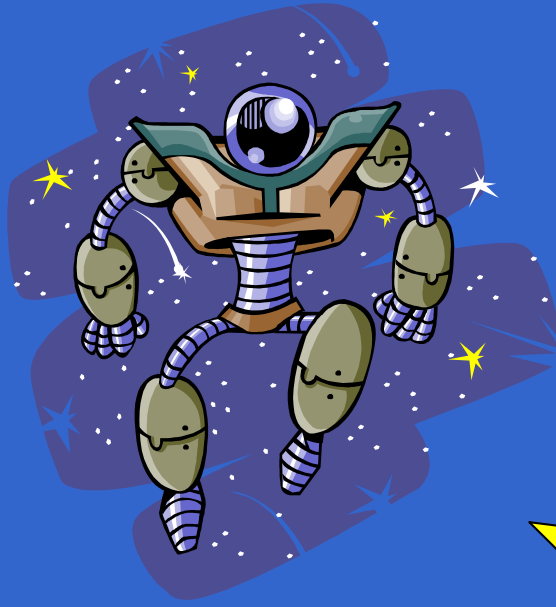




Realistic Fiction:
