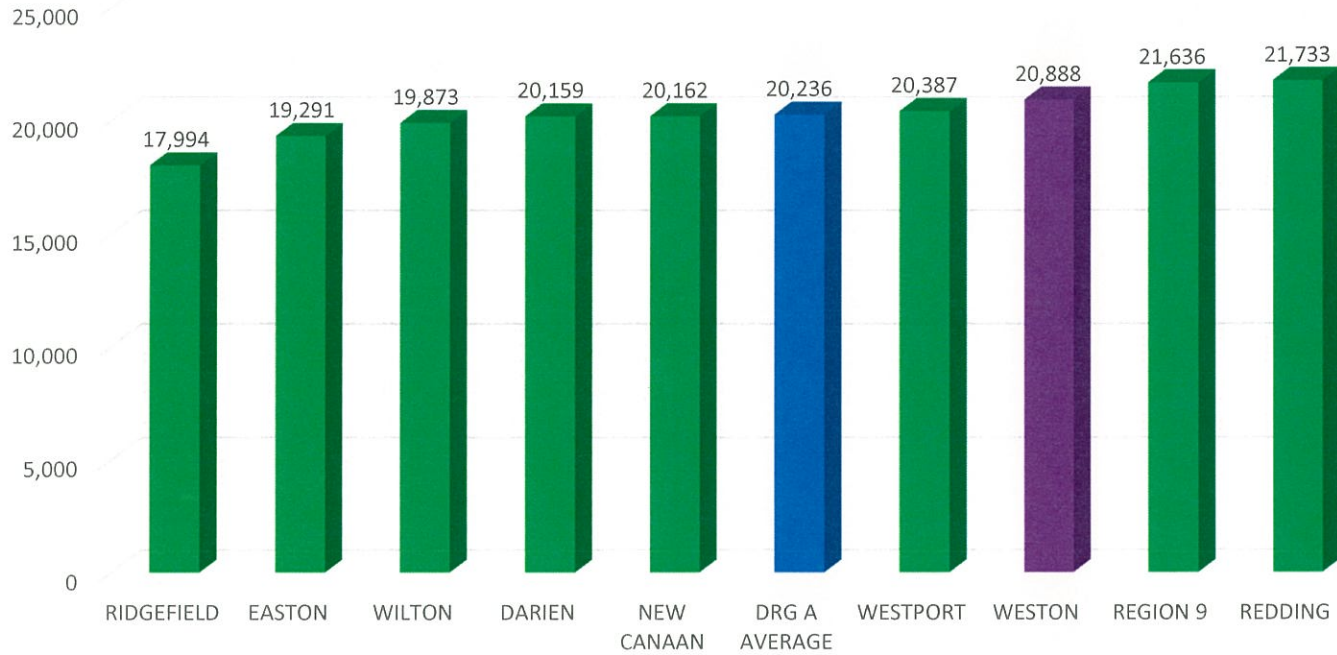

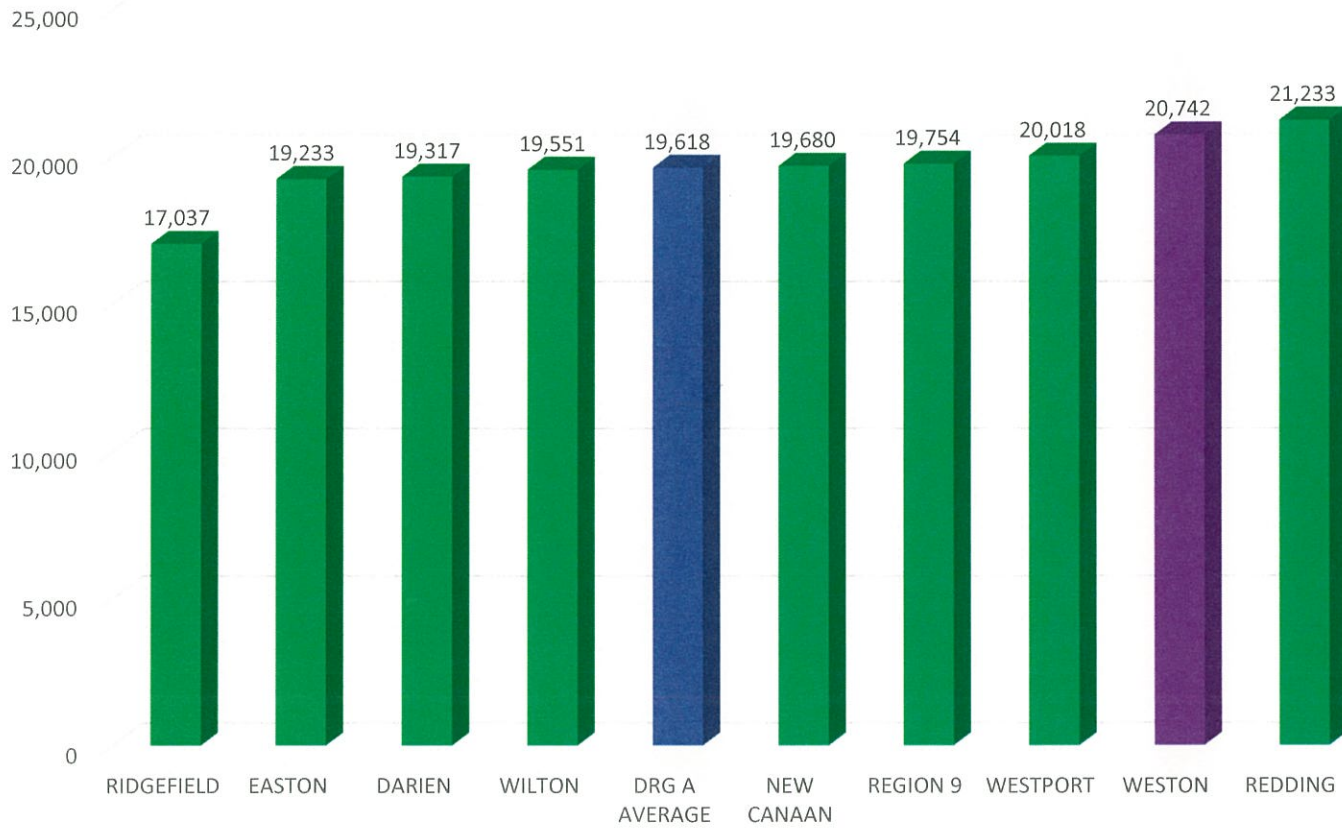

DRG A Per Pupil Expenditures 2015-2016



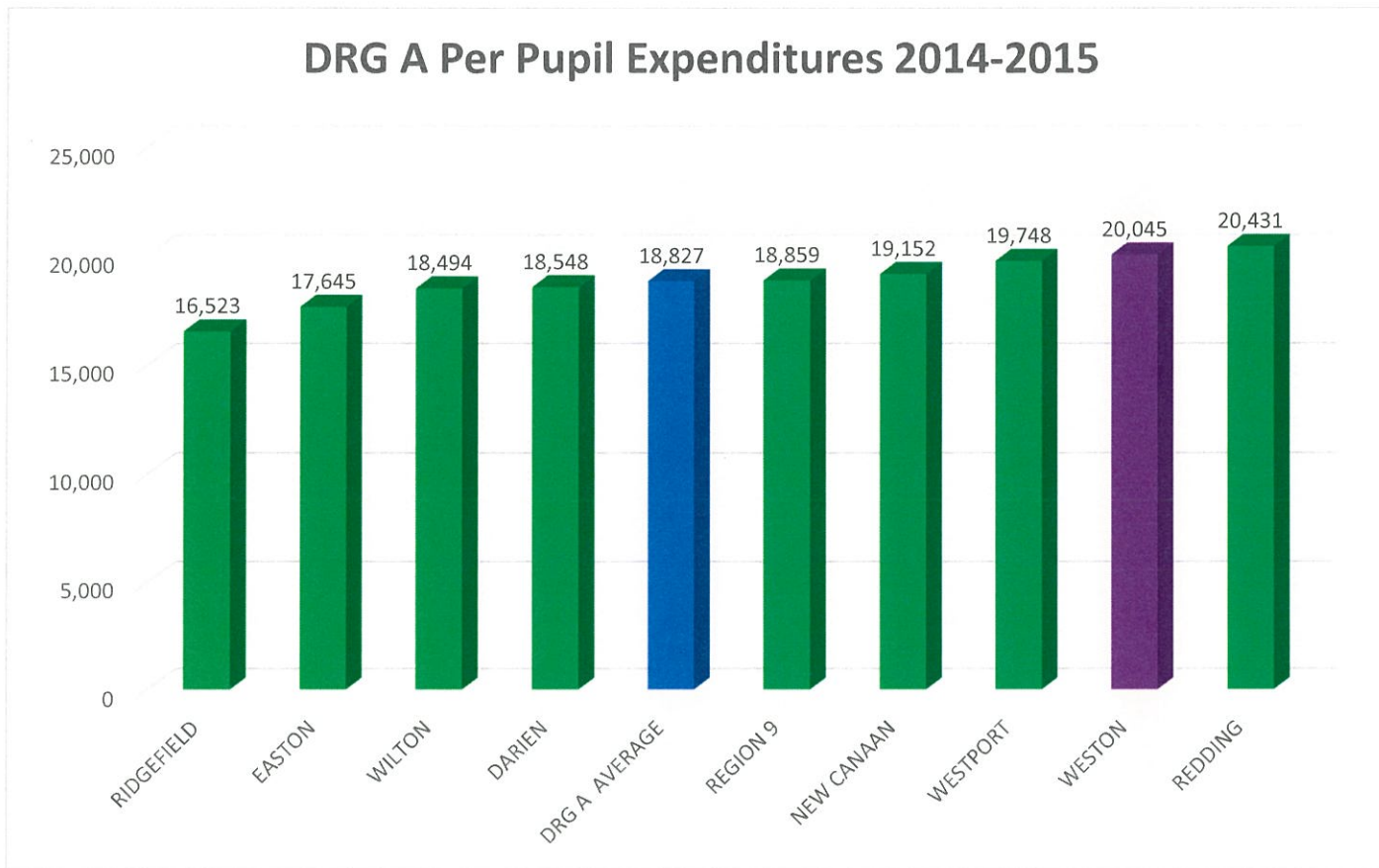
