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## REOPEN PLAN for 2021-2022

### ❖ IN – PERSON LEARNING AND ACTIVITIES

- In- person learning and activities will be offered to the greatest extent possible in order to address student's academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs.

### ❖ DAILY SCREENING

- Parents are asked to take temperatures before sending any student to school
- Temperatures shall be below 100.0
- If parents send their child to school, they are certified healthy.
- Students can be periodically checked while at school.
- Staff shall screen themselves. If an employee comes to work, they are certified healthy.

### ❖ AT SCHOOL PROCEDURES

- Any student or staff member who exhibits a fever of 100 degrees will be instantly isolated in a designated area and immediately sent home.
- The student will continue with distance learning at home until he/she can return to school.
- The student will be counted as present as long as the student is working on the learning plan provided.

### ❖ POSITIVE CASES AND EXPOSURES

- FPS will consult with the county health department to begin contact tracing.
- FPS administration will communicate with staff.
- Notifications will be sent to communicate with applicable parents/guardians.
- The classrooms will be thoroughly sanitized.

## ❖ **REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY TEACHERS**

- Teachers are asked to maximize classroom space.
- Student seating shall be best utilized by using classroom space.
- Seating charts are recommended for purposes of social distancing and contact tracing.
- Cleaning schedules will be developed for traffic areas by custodial staff.
- Student etiquette for handwashing and the covering of the nose/mouth for cough/sneezes will be addressed by all classroom teachers.

## ❖ **BUS TRANSPORTATION**

- Drivers shall maximize air flow.
- Seating chart for bus routes is recommended.

## ❖ **EXTRA CURRICULAR AND ACTIVITIES**

- Activities will be continued as scheduled until further notice

FPS will provide appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities on a case by case basis, with respect to health and safety needs.

FPS will continue to work diligently with State and Local Health officials for the health and wellness of all students and staff.

FPS will not be offering full time virtual education this year except for those with a written Dr. request.
