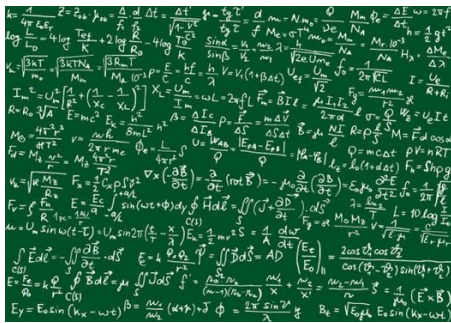




Middle School Mania
