

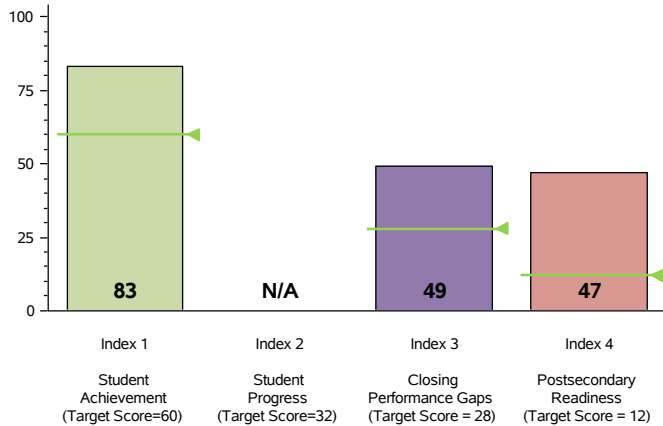

2017 Performance Index
