Steps to Becoming a Mentor (A Big)

- Complete an application and bring it to your interview.
- Schedule a time for us to have a 20 minute interview. This gives me a better idea of who you are and allows me to make the best match possible for you.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will I be able to choose the day to spend the hour with my Little?

The program runs on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays. You will have a choice of day and time: 2:30-3:30 or 3:30-4:30 pm.



If I am not able to make it on my "regular" day, can I make it up and come back a different day the same week, as long as I have an hour that week?

Yes, It is best to come the same consistent day, but sometimes a "make-up" day is need. Let the Program Coordinator know in advance which make-up day and time you are able to meet your Little. Communication is KEY!

Will I have an input on who my Little is?

We talk about preferences during your interview, so yes, you will have input on it.

Where is the office located?

We meet in the Middle School Room at the Boys and Girls Club. 247 Spring Rd, NW, Concord, NC 28025

What is the age range for Littles?

Our Littles are all elementary school students, ages range from 5–10 years old. During your interview we will talk about what you are comfortable with and take that into consideration with matching you with a Little.
