The Rosel Family Scholarship

The Rosel family wished to thank Liberal community for their contribution in providing for a standard living and quality education for our family. In appreciation, we have established a scholarship to be given to a graduating Liberal High School senior with plans to attend a 4 year college. This scholarship may be renewed if the student maintains eligibility and meets all requirements.

Student Eligibility

- 1) Liberal High School graduating senior.
- 2) Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).
- 3) Must have participated in 2 extracurricular activities per year for their 10th, 11th, & 12th years.
- 4) Must be enrolled in a 4-year accredited university as a full-time student.
- 5) Must be a natural born United States citizen.

To renew scholarship

- 1) Student must submit grades within 14 days from close of **each** semester to scholarship administrator (High Plains Heritage Foundation).
- 2) GPA must be at a 3.0 (on a 4.0) scale.
- 3) If GPA falls below 3.0, the scholar will be put on probation and given one semester to bring GPA 3.0 or above.
- 4) Must be a full-time student and all semesters must be consecutive.

Application Deadline

- 1) Application for graduating LHS seniors must be turned in to the counselor's office on or before March 19th of the current year.
- 2) Recipients will be notified on or before May 31st of each year and will have 10 days to accept the award. If not accepted, the scholarship committee may award the scholarship to the 1st alternate.

Application Requirements

- 1) Complete application
- 2) Current transcript from Liberal High School or attending college.
- 3) Birth certificate (on file).
- 4) National test score results (ACT, SAT, PSAT).
- 5) Must provide three character references other than family or teachers.
- 6) Include an essay in regard to your career and/or educational goals.
