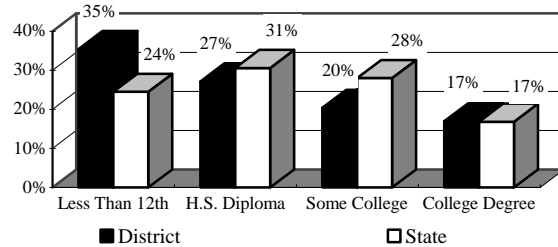


## Community Characteristics

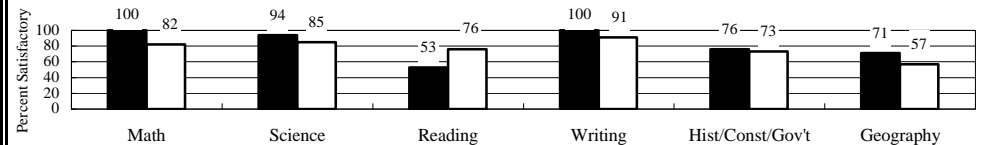
### 3rd Grade Iowa Test of Basic Skills

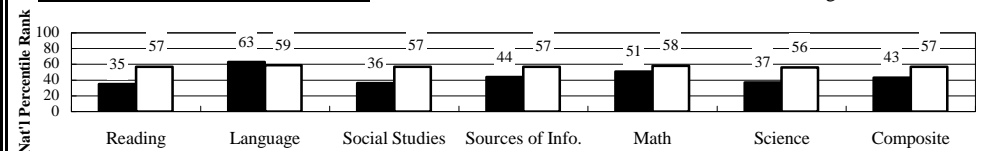
### 5th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test

This Site: 89% Tested State Average: 88% Tested



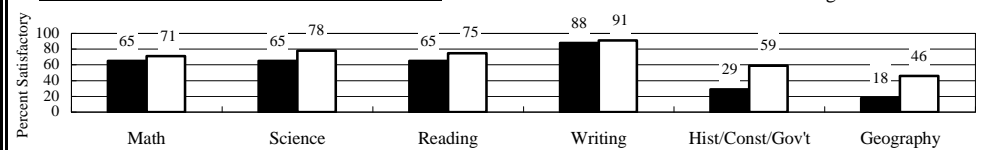
### 7th Grade Iowa Test of Basic Skills
