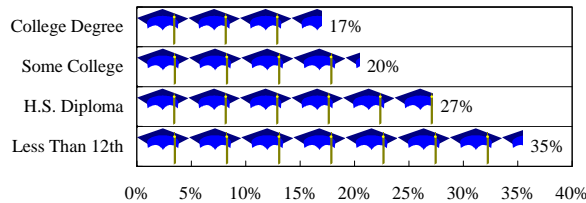

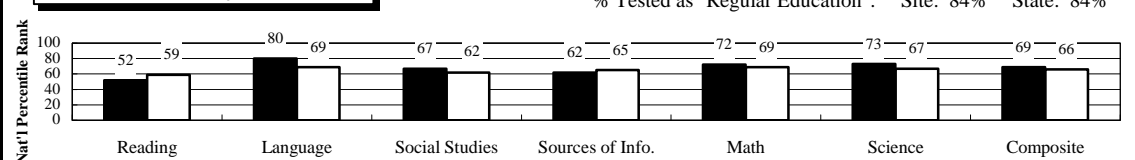

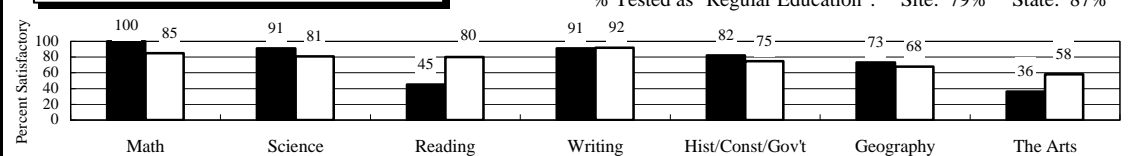

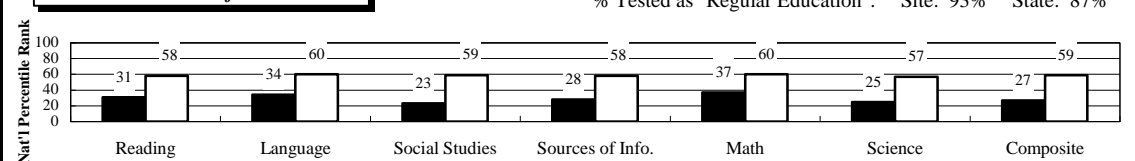
**3rd Grade Iowa Test of Basic Skills<sup>RM</sup>**



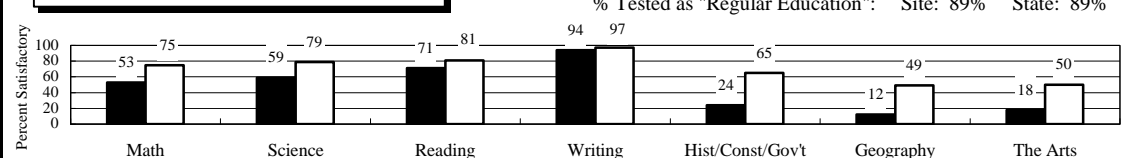
**5th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test<sup>RM</sup>**
