

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Cellular phones (Apple watches) and/or any other communication device will be generally prohibited from use during instruction time (unless the instructor allows this use in connection with a lesson plan or project). This dis-allowed use of a cellular phone or other communication device during instructional time has a disrupting effect on instructional time and takes away the focus of the task at hand when the instructor must collect and deliver to the Principal's office for pickup at the end of the day by a parent and sig corresponding form(s). District employees are instructed by administration to NOT view, inspect or attempt to use confiscated cellular/communication devices. The use of cellular devices may be allowed during student center time, hall pass time and lunchroom. ****If this privilege is abused or misused or becomes an area of disruption to the smooth operation of the school curriculum, the device will be collected and the privilege will be discontinued****. Teachers will also have the permission to require all students to place their cellular/communication devices in a designated place when entering their classroom for the duration of instructional time. Students may realize that different teachers may require different rules for each classroom and will abide by those differing rules during the instructional day. Other devices that are not allowed include: Personal CD, stereos, headphones, music devices, pages, video games, laser lights and any other device which may be unsafe or disrupt other students or the learning process in general.
