## Pittsburg Public School Updated Covid Protocols

## **Close Contact:**

- 1.) Individuals identified as close contacts are **ENCOURAGED** to monitor symptoms for 14 days after the last date of exposure. Individuals may remain at school without symptoms and **RECOMMENDED** to wear a mask. Should the individual start exhibiting COVID-related symptoms, it is strongly recommended that the individual isolate immediately.
- 2.) Individuals identified as close contacts **CAN** quarantine for 5 days from last exposure and then take a Covid test. If the test is negative, then individual may return to school. If the test is positive, then individual must follow guidelines listed below.

## **Positive Covid Test**

If you test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status – Isolate

If you have COVID-19 symptoms, stay home until:

- 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, AND
- symptoms are improving, AND
- If fever is present, continue to stay home until 24 hours have passed since fever has resolved without the use of fever-reducing medications.

If you never have COVID-19 symptoms, stay home until

- 5 days have passed since the date of your COVID-19 test was collected, AND
- No COVID-19 symptoms have developed since you were tested.
