# MISS DEKALB PAGEANT RULES AND INFORMATION

**Date of Orientation: January 27th, 2019 at 2:00 p.m.**, High School Cafeteria (Be dressed for newspaper pictures and bring picture and applications)

**Date of Pageant: March 9th, 2019**, Interviews beginning that morning and the pageant at 6 p.m. Rehearsal will begin March 4th-8th, 2019.

The DeKalb pageant consists of 9 categories:

- Baby Miss- under 24 months at Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018)
- Toddler Miss- ages 2 and 3 (by Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018)
- Tiny Miss- PK4 (or 4 by Sept.1<sup>st</sup>) and Kindergarten
- Little Miss – grades 1 and 2
- Petite Miss – grades 3 and 4
- Young Miss – grades 5 and 6
- Junior Miss – grades 7 and 8
- Teen Miss- grades 9 and 10
- Miss – grades 11 and 12

Contestant must reside in DeKalb, Malta or Hubbard school district if not enrolled in school yet. Contestant must reside in and attend Hubbard or Malta school district OR be enrolled in DeKalb ISD to enter any of the older categories. **There is a \$20 entry fee for the pageant.**

If a contestant wins any of the Miss DeKalb titles and moves from DeKalb (except for seniors moving to college) she forfeits her title and the 1<sup>st</sup> runner up will receive the title. If any of the Miss DeKalb winners (any age group) becomes pregnant, she forfeits her title and the 1<sup>st</sup> runner up will receive the title. Also, Miss DeKalb contestants may not already be a mother. Each contestant must be a student in **good standing** at the school where she attends. Students who have a recorded discipline record, regarding drugs or alcohol, either from the school or law enforcement, or arrest with the law, may not be allowed to participate as a contestant, and will also forfeit her crown if it occurs after the pageant. DeKalb Professional Women's Organization has the right to refuse participation based on these criteria. Students must also have parental permission to participate.

## **Forms**

Please complete the attached forms. Print neatly or type each form. You will turn in the entry form, (1) EMCEE sheet, (1) Judges Sheets (we will make copies), and (1) **picture for the program** at orientation. If you do not have a picture then we will take it at orientation.

Remember that these are the sheets that will be given to the judges. Put the most recent accomplishments and most special events on the EMCEE sheets. Please emphasize about your child in the Judges sheets.

All photos will be returned to you after the pageant. **All photos and sheets are due at orientation.**

## **Ads**

You can sell or purchase family or good luck ads for the program book. Contestants are not to sell ads to businesses. Photos of your choice may also be used in the ads. Personal ad sales information, pictures and money are due no later than Feb. 1st, 2019. Cost of Ads are \$50.00 full page, \$25.00 ½ page, \$15.00 ¼ page and \$10.00 for 1/8 page (no

pictures in this ad). Ads need to be turned in at the orientation, or if more time is necessary- Feb. 1st is the final deadline. They can be turned in at the DeKalb ISD Central Office at 101 Maple. St.

### **Photogenic**

There will also be an award given for Most Photogenic. This picture must be a **black and white 5X7 head shot**. There is a \$20 fee for this, but it is optional. Whether or not you enter a picture for Miss Photogenic has no outcome on the winners of the pageant. Photogenic pics are due to DeKalb ISD Central Office by Monday, February 29<sup>th</sup>.

### **Interviews**

Interviews will be held the day of the pageant at DeKalb ISD Central Office. All age groups will be interviewed except Baby, Toddler, and Tiny Miss. The Little Miss division will be held as small groups interviews, all others will be individual interviews. Please wear an appropriate dress of your choice. Parents are not allowed to attend the interview sessions. INTERVIEWS ARE ½ OF YOUR SCORE FOR LITTLE MISS, PETITE MISS, YOUNG MISS, JUNIOR MISS, AND TEEN MISS. IT MAKES UP ⅓ OF YOUR SCORE FOR MISS DEKALB (interview, casual wear, formal wear).

### **TALENT COMPETITION- (OPTIONAL)**

**The 2019 Pageant will include a talent competition for girls in grades 9-12. This competition is for any talent the contestant would like to do- with approval from the Professional Women's Organization. There is a fee of \$20 for this competition.**

**To be in the talent competition, you must also participate in either the Teen Miss or Miss DeKalb Competition. However, the talent competition will not be have any factor in the overall score for Teen Miss, or Miss DeKalb. It is voluntary only. A \$50 cash award will be given to the winner!**

### **Pageant Information**

The pageant opening number will include the Miss age division and the attire will be announced at a later date. The DeKalb Professional Women's Organization usually purchases the majority of the outfit. Details on the opening number will be given to the Miss contestants at a later date.

The Miss division also competes in Casual Wear. This is an outfit of your choice, but must not have any bare middles or be excessively short. Articles of clothing may be removed as long as the above rule of coverage is still followed. Remember coverage and taste is the key! Must be approved!

The formal wear in each division is as follows: Baby, Toddler & Tiny Miss – Short pageant dress; Little Miss – Short pageant dress, Petite Miss – Short or Full length pageant dress, Young, Junior, Teen, and Miss- Full Length Pageant dress

Miss contestants are not allowed to leave from backstage to go to the audience, back side rooms or outside during rehearsal or competition. One parent of each Baby and Toddler Miss contestant will be allowed to accompany their child backstage and walk during the rehearsal and competition, but the parent must stay with the staff person for that age division and exit immediately following the completion of their rehearsal or competition. Parents, please emphasize to your child that every child will not win a crown, but every child is a winner. Please help your child learn to be a gracious winner or loser. If the parents of the younger age groups would like to go in together and buy participation trophies for all the girls' that is permissible.

**All proceeds from this pageant go toward scholarships for seniors.**

Members of DeKalb Professional Women's Organization who have children competing in the pageant may not sponsor or help with that age division. No special treatment will be extended.
