


The following is a list of the business to be conducted by the Board of Education at the above meeting:

- 4) Board to discuss continuing disclosure obligations.
- 5) Board to receive bids for the \$1,650,000 General Obligation Building Bonds of this school district and award bonds to the lowest bidder.
- 6) Board to consider and take action on a resolution providing for the issuance of General Obligation Building Bonds in the sum of \$1,650,000 by this school district, authorized at an election called and held for such purpose; prescribing form of bonds; providing for registration thereof; providing for levy of an annual tax for the payment of principal and interest on the same; and fixing other details of the issue.
- 7) Board to discuss with possible action to hire or not hire Carolyn Frazier as Third Grade Instructor for the remainder of the 2018-19 school year.
- 8) Board to discuss with possible action to approve or not approve a bid for computer equipment.
- 9) Adjournment.
