Dear Parents,

Our district has now received our online STAAR results for Spring 2017. There are changes being made to the score reports that are sent home to you, therefore there is a delay in school districts receiving those reports. We know that you are anxious to view your child's assessment results, so we want to inform you that you may access those scores online. Follow the steps below to access your child's results:

- Go to www.texasassessment.com.
- Click Log Into Student Portal in the purple box.
- You will need your child's access code. This can be found at the bottom of all STAAR score reports from previous years. If you do not have a copy of a previous year's score report, click on Look Up Access Code. You will need to enter your child's first name, social security number in the PEIMS ID field, and the birthdate. Click Go. The access code should appear. Click Go again. Your child's assessment history should appear.

The name of each assessment your child has taken will be highlighted in blue. You can click on each one of the assessments to view more detailed information on your child's performance. If your child's score falls in the Approaches, Meets, or Masters range, they have passed the assessment. If the score falls in the Did Not Meet range, they have not successfully passed the assessment.

The old score reports were known as Confidential Student Reports (CSR). The new reports will be known as the STAAR Report Card. The STAAR Report Card will include more detailed information than the CSR. They should be easier to read and provide more explanation for you than the previous reports did. We are scheduled to receive paper copies of the STAAR Report Cards the week of July 10. As soon as we receive those, they will be mailed home to you.
