

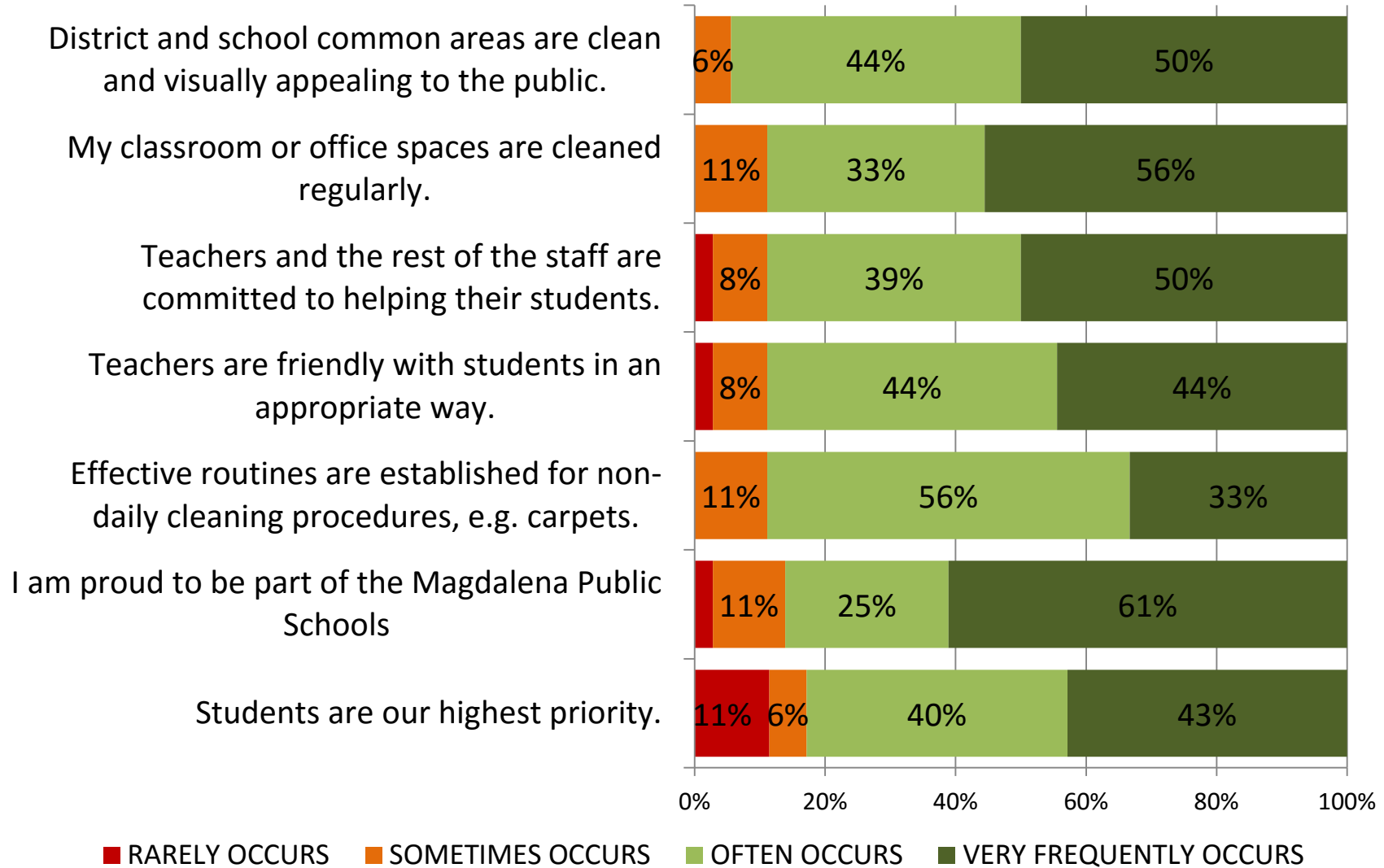
# Climate Survey at Magdalena Municipal School District

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At the end of the 2017-18 school year, Magdalena staff participated in a survey to better understand the physical, social, and academic life of our schools – also known as our “school climate.” Staff answered 47 questions about a range of topics, such as whether we have high expectations for our students, what changes they’d like to see in the district, how well staff works together, and areas where we’re doing well.

This survey will help the superintendent and school board identify areas where we’re doing well, and areas where we could do better. On the next two graphs, you can find how the staff responded to some of the questions that the survey asked. The first graph shows the areas where we’re doing well, which includes the cleanliness and upkeep of our schools and the way our staff feels about our district and students. The second graph shows areas where we could do better, including having a better district vision, more positive staff recognition, and increased communication across the district. We look forward to working with our school community to make MMDS an even better place for our staff and students.
