



Emergency Broadband Benefit

The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) program is a new program that provides a temporary discount on home internet bills for qualifying low-income households. New Mexico Student Connect is here to help you navigate this program.

Eligible households can qualify for:

Monthly Benefit

Up to a \$50/month discount on your broadband service and associated equipment rentals

Enhanced Tribal Benefit

Up to a \$75/month discount if your household is on qualifying Tribal lands

One-time Device Discount

Up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer (with a co-payment of more than \$10 but less than \$50) where available

What are the steps?

1	Confirm your household's eligibility for EBB by visiting GetEmergencyBroadband.org
2	Click "Apply Now" to apply for EBB at GetEmergencyBroadband.org
3	Visit <u>NMStudentConnect.org/ISPMap</u> to find a participating Internet Service Provider in your area
4	Call your selected Internet Service Provider at the number listed in the table below the map
