Conversations with Mrs. Clark

My goodness, what a start to the school year! I'm sure each of you is feeling the stress with your children and are struggling the same as we are no matter what our feelings are regarding COVID. I wanted to clarify any contact coming out of the mid and high-school office. If your child has had INDIRECT contact with someone that has tested positive, you will receive a letter via text message. The text will state if the person that tested positive is in mid or high school so you are better informed. Your child can continue to come to school as normal. If your child was in DIRECT contact with a positive person for more than 15 minutes and within the 3 ft. distance we will contact you personally. If your child is fully vaccinated they can come to school as normal as long as they are not showing any symptoms. If your child is not vaccinated they will need to quarantine for 10 days.
