 - Prairiland School District
 - Detroit School District
 - Rivercrest High School
- 2. Student Qualifications;
 - Students parent, grandparent or legal guardian must be active duty military or a veteran of military service (honorably discharged).
 - Student must provide a copy of the appropriate DD214 as proof of the members honorable discharge. (The DD214 will be returned to the student).
 - Scholastic and attendance qualifications will be determined by each awarding public school district.
- 3. \$1500.00 will go to each school to be used for either college or trade school tuition/books. The \$1500 may be divided as follows: one \$1500, two \$750 or three \$500 dollars scholarships at the school districts discretion.
- 4. School districts will conduct all interviewing, and make final decision on individual(s).
- 5. The scholarships will be called the" American Legion Post 199 Deport, Texas Scholarship" A member of Post 199 should be present and award scholarship(s) at the schools award ceremony/dinner.
- 6. Scholarship funding will come from the general operating fund.

 Subsequent years funding will be derived from setting up a scholarship fund supported by interest/dividends from the Post 199 investment account (s).
- 7. If student does not use the Scholarship within 2 years; It will revert back to the Post Scholarship Fund.
- 8. Point of contact for the school districts will be the Post 199 Commander and Adjutant with their phone numbers.
