

WHAT is COLLEGE NOW DUAL CREDIT?

Dual Credit is a form of concurrent enrollment that allows a student to take approved courses at San Jacinto College that earn both college and high school credit. Typically, students take two courses (6 college hours) per semester while in high school. By doing this, students can graduate from high school with 24+ hours of college credit! You can earn even more college credits by taking summer courses.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students should meet with their College Now Coordinator to begin the admission process.

To apply for the dual credit program, students need to meet the eligibility requirements and then submit the following:

- Submit a college application
- Fulfill testing requirements
- Provide proof of bacterial meningitis immunization
- Complete the Dual Credit enrollment form
- Pay for classes once registered
- Purchase textbooks

TRANSPORTATION

PISD provides bus transportation from the student's home campus to the appropriate San Jacinto College Campus for 7:00 am and 1:30 pm college classes during the school year and for specific summertime classes as well.

COST

Dual Credit at San Jacinto College is affordable. Students pay only 25% of tuition and fees for approved courses that count toward both high school and college. Students may also be covered for the remaining amount if they qualify for the Texas Public Education Grant (TPEG). Students are also responsible for purchasing textbooks. INSTRUCTORS

Courses are taught on the San Jacinto College campus by San Jacinto College faculty. San Jacinto College reserves certain sections for Dual Credit students; therefore, students may not choose specific professors.
