The District Leadership Team (DLT) has met and is moving forward with the district improvement model KESA. We will be meeting with our Outside Validation Team (OVT) later this year to see how we are progressing. We have chosen to enter into the 5 year cycle in year 3 as we believe we have successfully completed years 1 and 2 already. As you are aware, we will focus our district on Relationships and Rigor tabs of the KESA model. The buildings have chosen their goals to reach and we will be moving in this direction as a district. Very excited to see the changes that are happening for our students, staff, school and community.

The iReady (reading) program that is being taught at WMS has been moving at a very quick pace. Students and staff have picked up on this model very well. My observations have been very positive. Students are working hard in these classes and I believe the results will be very positive when they start coming in. As with the math curriculum, it will take time to really see major results, but if we stick to this pilot, I believe our students will see positive results.
