

WJRC Director's Report for May 2017

WJRC will begin our youth sports games mid-May. The WHS seasons should finish their games the second week in May. Then we will begin prepping the fields/complex for rec season. We have 30 youth t-ball, baseball and softball teams playing this season at Saddle Club Park; so we will be busy! We have 3 league tournaments scheduled at Saddle Club Park this summer (June 24th, June 25th & July 7th - 9th).

Our spring adult softball league will finish May 30th. We will begin our summer session in June.

This spring, WJRC has been improving our playground. We had repair work done to our playground structure and painted the structure in hopes it extends the life of the playground for several years. There have been several people within the community who have expressed their thoughts on how much they like the new location on the playground (moved from the south corner of the park to the middle of the park). We have also added one piece of equipment with a second "spinner" piece of equipment to be installed over the next couple of weeks. WJRC has also purchased three recycled benches to be placed at the playground for adults to sit.

WJRC will be working on making our website more "user-friendly" for our program participants to navigate. This is will be a lengthy but worthy project this summer.

Another improvement for this summer/spring are the increased options for concessions at Saddle Club Park. We have added items such as pulled pork, french fries, nachos, etc. We feel that our patrons deserve quality concessions when spending their weeknights at our complex.
