

Director's Report for October BOE Meeting

WJRC just recently hosted an All-Night Adult Coed Softball Tournament at Saddle Club Park. We had several local teams as well as several others from other towns. WJRC Staff provided concessions for the tournament and had a few items that were donated and raffled off. The tournament was a great success and will continue to provide more adult tournaments going forward.

WJRC Staff is currently working on the fields for next spring. All the infields have been re-shaped with a sod cutter and in some spots, will be either be replaced with sod or filled in with infield material. It is important to do this now so the material has a chance to settle during the winter. The sod will be laid this week and give us a couple weeks (with warmer weather still upon us) to water it before it cools off. WJRC Staff will also install the foul poles on field #1 before winter.

WJRC is hoping to begin work on the new batting cages at the end of this month. We will look locally for a company to level out the area by field #2 and hopefully get a footing poured before winter approaches. WJRC will update on the status of the project in future reports.
