As we enter our second century of service, it is a true honor to continue to support you in your local mission. This letter outlines the services we offer and the direct benefits of belonging to KASB as well as our dues structure and membership fee for our Legal Assistance Fund.

Serving education leaders, Inspiring student success. As a member of KASB, you join close to 3,500 governing board members and administrators who share your commitment to public education. KASB dues are based on a formula that takes into consideration a district's general fund budget. Our board of directors voted the past two years to freeze dues because member budgets were frozen due to the state's block grant funding. For the coming year, the board of directors has approved returning the dues structure to the approved formula. Therefore, members may see a change in dues over the previous two years.

The Season Pass remains the same at \$1,500. This pass continues to provide a great value to our members. You can register as many board members/staff for KASB workshops/trainings as you wish. By purchasing the pass at a one-time fee, you can more easily plan for the costs of training as you build your budget for the year.

A culture of collaboration and service. 
We focus on timely support, delivered in the most convenient and cost-efficient method possible. Members can access legal support and training onsite, through email, by phone or through web conferencing.

By moving our legal publications online we will update content more frequently, and you will have immediate access to information you require.

The KASB Board of Directors voted to increase our Legal Assistance Fund membership fee to \$2,100. The increased fee allows us to provide and maintain the high quality legal services you have come to expect. Enclosed is a separate contract and invoice for the KASB Legal Assistance Fund consultant service fee. By providing this service through a separate fee from your regular KASB dues, the attorney/client relationship is protected. This guarantees confidential legal representation for our members. Only local boards belonging to KASB are eligible to join the Legal Assistance Fund. Even though a local board may be a member of KASB, legal services cannot be provided unless the district is also a member of the Legal Assistance Fund.
