The first nine weeks is completed. I am pleased with the progress staff has made with our students. We continue to move forward with our new accreditation system and will schedule a review very soon in the spring. We will continue to meet the system goals needed to show improvement. I am proud of how our staff has tackled this new system.

Most of the kinks with the new cameras and locks we have installed have been worked out. This has been a nice added security for our schools. The access our administrative staff has via the internet is good. The card system has proven to be a very positive system for our security of our schools. Cameras have been used to solve issues that happened at our volleyball tournament by an outsider to solve a crime. All of this is just a sidebar to the safety of our students and staff. These two items are very beneficial to our district.

Enrollment is up in our district. Not very many, but 3 is better than zero. Where we will make up the difference is in our Full Time Equivalence (FTE). We will be up there and the main reason we will be up is because our Kindergarten students now count as 1 rather than a half. Next budget year will be based on current numbers with a few exceptions. We will not know exactly what our budget will be for next year until then, but we will know it should go up just a little.
