

WJRC Director's Report for January 2017 BOE Meeting

WJRC's basketball leagues are in full swing. We currently have both rec and competitive leagues in session; our first and second grade league start January 21st. Youth soccer registration is currently open to the public and it closes March 3rd.

WJRC has a plan to renovate the Saddle Club Park batting cages. The current cages are in poor shape. The plan is to add a stall and have three cages and an area for soft toss. The cages will also have used field turf (cheaper than brand new turf) as the base of the cages. This new plan would allow the high school, youth teams and the community a better area to work on hitting/pitching. WJRC is taking closed bids until February 6th from multiple companies (both local and out-of-town), and will open the bids at the next WJRC Board Meeting. The anticipated date of completion is March 10th.

WJRC is currently working on moving all our tools and field equipment from the Morton Building (building attached to the concession stand/bathrooms) to the barn. This would allow for better storage of our sports equipment, concession items and allow umpires a place to change/rest for ball games. It also provides better security for our field equipment with the only point of entry to the barn facing Pendleton Ave.

We will update the BOE on these projects next month.
