BOARD INTERNAL ORGANIZATION: CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEES BDF (LEGAL)

The Board shall establish a local school health advisory council to assist the District in ensuring that local community values and health issues are reflected in the District's health education instruction. The Board shall appoint members to the council, a majority of which must be parents of students enrolled in the District and who are not employed by the District.

The District shall publish in the student handbook and post on the District's Internet Web site information about Board policies affecting student wellness and information about the School Health Advisory Council (SHAC). With this in mind, information shall be posted on the BISD Web site on an annual basis to inform parents and community about students' wellness needs.

Physical Fitness Assessment

Annually the district will conduct a physical fitness assessment of students in grades 3 – 12. At the end of the school year, a parent may submit a written request to the principal to obtain the results of his or her child's physical fitness assessment conducted during the school year.
