WE DO NOT TRANSPORT TO BABYSITTERS, ALTERNATE ADDRESSES, AND PLACES OF BUSINESS. ONLY ONE ADDRESS IS ALLOWED FOR THE REGULAR DAILY PICK UP AND DROP OFF.**

**BISD SCHOOL BUSES:**

The fleet of 17 buses travel more than 1,000 miles daily over 21 routes to transport more than 700 students to and from school; the buses are part of a well-organized, safety-oriented transportation system with each bus inspected and repaired daily.

**THE SCHOOL BUS DRIVER:**

The school bus driver has sometimes been referred to as the silent teacher. Because of the precious cargo transported by these drivers, great care is given to their qualifications, certification, training, and operational requirements. Drivers must pass strenuous physical and medical exams as prescribed by the state.

**Please read attached bus rules and regulations.**

**SAFETY**

The school district staff and bus drivers share concern with the safety of your child. You can assist in providing a safe bus ride by instructing him/her in the **following safety and conduct rules:**

Stand off the street and away from the curb and wait until the bus is **completely stopped** before moving toward the bus.

**Arrive** at the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled stop time.

**Go directly to your seat and be seated.** Do not stand while the bus is in motion.

Keep your arms and legs out of the aisles.

**Do not distract driver.** Their full attention should be on operating the bus.

You should not play loud music or musical instruments.

**Do not talk** to the driver except in an emergency.

Use the handrail while entering and exiting the bus.

Do not crowd the steps.

**The emergency door in the rear of the bus is to be used in emergencies only.**

It is not to be used for boarding or exiting the bus.

**Do not throw trash, candy, or chewing gum on the floor or on the seats.**

Help keep the bus clean and sanitary.

Smoking on the bus is prohibited.

When students get off the bus, they should move away from the unloading zone quickly.

**Misconduct on the bus will not be tolerated. Children who do not conduct themselves properly may lose bus riding privileges.**

**Beeville ISD provides the bus service for your conveniences try not to lose your bus riding privileges.**

**Beeville ISD is not responsible for lost or stolen items left on the bus or on the route.**
