

The following activities are a part of the entrance assessments and interview process for the AC Jones Health Professions Magnet Academy. **Please arrive at least 10 minutes before your scheduled interview time.** Interview dates and times cannot be exchanged or modified except in cases of emergency. No cell phones or other electronic devices are permitted during testing.

Part 1: Writing Assessment (30 minutes)

- You will receive an expository writing prompt.
- You will respond to the prompt by writing an essay.
- You will have a maximum of 26 lines to write your response.
- Make sure each sentence you write helps the reader understand your essay.
- Make sure your ideas are clear and easy for the reader to follow.
- Write your ideas in detail so the reader really understands your response.
- Check your work for correct spelling, capitalization, punctuation, and grammar.
- The essay will be written on site.

Part 2: Interviews


- **Student Interview (10 minutes)**
