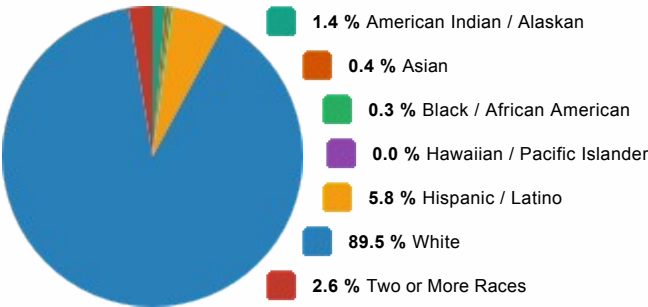

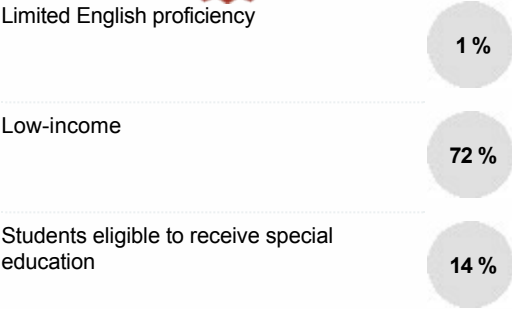


STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS
