

District 504 Information

1. **Who is eligible for Section 504?**

A person with a disability means any person who:

- has a **physical or mental impairment** which **substantially limits** one or more **major life activities**,
- has a record of such an impairment,
- or is regarded as having such an impairment

2. **What are some examples of impairments, which may qualify under Section 504?**

- ADHD
- Bipolar Disorder
- Dyslexia
- Cerebral Palsy
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Epilepsy
- Diabetes
- and many more.

3. **What are some examples of non-impairments, which would *not* qualify?**

- English Language Learners
- Poverty
- Transiency
- Meer differences between people
- Normal pregnancy
- Relative weakness in cognitive areas
- Common personality traits such as poor judgment or quick temper where these are not symptoms of a mental or psychological disorder
- Pre-disposition to illness or disease
- Family issues such as divorce or death of a family member
