NOTE: Any student enrolled on a Residency Affidavit may be subject to home visits by Harrah Administrators, other school personnel or School Resources Officers as deemed necessary.

I solemnly swear that the information given above related to the affidavit is completely true and accurate. I understand that if these conditions are found to be false that the student named above will forfeit their legal enrollment status, will be withdrawn from school. year. I acknowledge that willful misstatement in this affidavit, known by me to be false, shall be a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment not to exceed one (1) year or a fine not to exceed five-hundred (\$500) or both such fine and imprisonment in accordance with 70 O.S., Sec. 1-113 of state law.

Decisions regarding intra-district transfers will be made by the receiving site principal. Students enrolled on a *Residence Affidavit* may be eligible to apply for out of district transfer as a returning student. Residence status must be renewed every year.

The person who is requesting the residence affidavit **must provide 3 pieces of current and differing business mail addressed to them at the Harrah address at the time of enrollment. If residence is a rental property, the owner must add the names of the new residents (adults and children) to the lease and submit a copy to the school office prior to completion of enrollment.** The Harrah resident must provide a copy of a current gas, electric or propane bill. Failure to do so will result in delay of the student's enrollment.

***Approved Affidavit will only be valid for the current school year.**
