- ***Due to Covid-19 concerns, school lockers will not be utilized until further notice. Students will be required to keep all of their supplies with them throughout the day. - 1 pencil sharpener hand held, keep in pouch
- 5 1-inch binders (hardback preferred) with pockets red--SS, blue--Science, white-Language, gray-Reading, black--Math, take to class with you
- 5 boxes of tissues (give one to each core teacher)
- 1 pencil pouch to keep
- 5 pkg of pencils 24 count or higher (give one to each core teacher)
- Face mask / covering (required)

For English- 4 pack of highlighters (yellow, green, pink, blue) give to your English teacher

For Math--- 1- ***TI 30xs calculator*** (mandatory as this is the same one students use on the state test at the end of year) also the one they will use in high school---it is good for 2-3 years.
