



A+ Charter Schools Athletic Events Bag policy

Founders Stadium Bag Policy

To ensure guest safety and quicker entry into Founders Stadium, A+ Charter Schools will utilize a Clear Bag Policy. All bags are subject to inspections by school staff. Each ticketed person is permitted to bring the following items into ticketed events:

BAG POLICY ALLOWED ITEMS:

- Clear tote - plastic, vinyl or PVC bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Plastic storage bag - Clear one (1) gallon or smaller, re-sealable.
- Small clutch size handbags- approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap. No larger than 6.5" and 4.5" with or without a handle or strap and subject to inspection.
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection.

Prohibited bags

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Briefcases
- Camera Bags
- Fanny Packs
- Computer Bags
- Coolers
- Luggage of any kind
- Diaper Bags



- Drawstring Bags

Bleachers Conduct:

- No artificial noise makers will be permitted in the stadium. No air horns. No whistles. Only man-made noise makers are allowed. Examples include small shakers, inflatable boom sticks, clacker, and cowbells.
- No face paint or sign paint allowed in the stadium.
- No loitering will be permitted. Spectators must sit in the stands. Except when being used aisles should be kept clear at all times. Students may not cross to the other side of the stadium.
- Spectators are not permitted to stand along the field fencing / rail.
- All signs and banners must be to promote the school team and program. No negative signs toward opponent. No signs or hung from the top rail fence. At the closure of event, designated personnel from each school will remove all signage and straps.
- Baby powder or powder of any kind plus any item that causes safety concerns or an undue amount of time to clean up are prohibited in stadium. Balls of any kind are not to be thrown into the stands by cheerleaders or booster groups. Live animal mascots are prohibited.



Approved bags

While we encourage guests not to bring bags, if possible, the following are permissible:



- Clear tote - plastic, vinyl or PVC bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
