



Vroom! Vroom! Car Line Drop Off & Car Line Pick Up

Drop Off

Beginning Tuesday, March 3, please pull up as far as you can to the cones for Morning drop off. This will allow more cars to be able to unload and hopefully get you through the line quicker and on your way. A few reminders...

- Help your child have his/her backpack ready so when you are at the sidewalk, he/she can quickly get out of the car and walk to the doors.
- You may unload when your car is parked by the sidewalk. Please do **NOT** wait until you are behind the crosswalk.
- Give a *quick* hug and a kiss and send your little one on their way.
- Please have **PATIENCE!** Children have emotions that may not be the calmest on some days. A parent may be struggling with settling their little one down trying to get them to school.

Car Line Pick Up

The fire lane **MUST** remain clear of traffic. If there was a need for the fire department or paramedics to be here, we need all emergency vehicles to have access to the parking that has been designated for them. Therefore...

- Please park in one of the designated parking lots and walk across to pick up your child.
- **DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRE LANE!**
- Children must be picked up by **ADULTS** - not siblings. Children walking with children across the parking lot increases risk of an accident.
- Unless you have a handicapped sign posted on your rearview mirror, you are **NOT** to park in a handicapped parking spot.

Drop Off Parking Lot

Please **PARK** in a parking spot and walk your child over to the crosswalk or to the front entrance instead of stopping in the middle of the lot and letting your child out. There are cars trying to park, back out, and make their way through the lot. If you are sitting in the middle of the parking lot, then you are blocking the path of others who, like you, are needing to get on their way.
