Oklahoma is counting on you!

Everyone living in the United States is asked to complete a simple questionnaire every ten years that asks for basic information about the people who live or sleep in their home.

Filling out the 2020 Census is an easy, safe, and important way to help provide resources for children and their communities for the next 10 years.

When individuals are not counted, programs supporting health insurance, hospitals, child care, food assistance, schools, and early childhood development are under-funded.

Tips for Families:

- Count babies and children of all ages (even newborns and infants) living with you, including biological, step, and adopted children, as well as grandchildren, foster children, and children in joint custody arrangements.
- Count children where they live and sleep most of the time, even if their parents do not live there, they are not related to the person completing the census, or they are not related to the person who owns or rents the property.
- If a child's time is divided between more than one home, count them where they stay most often. If their time is evenly divided between homes, or you don't know where they stay most often, count them where they stayed on April 1, 2020.
