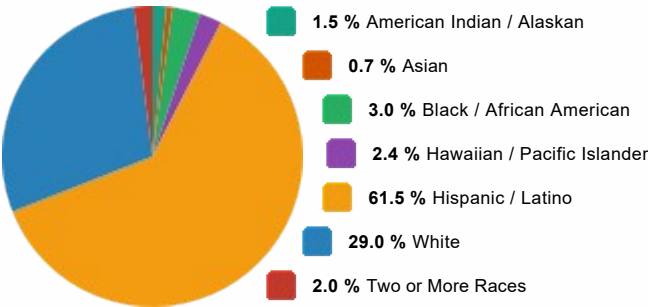

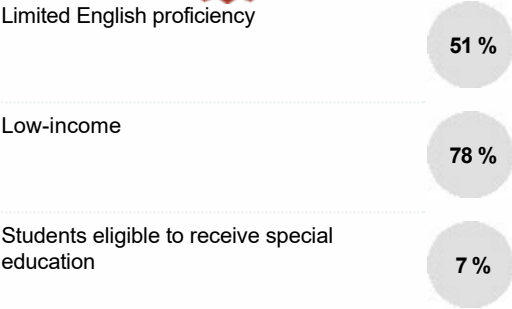


STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS
